Background: The Servant's Heart Awards is the name for Civitan International's global awareness project, which is suggested to be carried out during Civitan Awareness Month in April. This project is to honor teachers, paraprofessionals, and therapists who support people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. These educators are the unsung heroes in our communities. They can be found in school classrooms, service providers, for example, like Civitan House, Ridge Road House, and, vocational settings where skills are being taught, and, other agencies/programs.

Because this is our first attempt, as a Club, to sponsor The Servant's Heart Award; and because we have a limited length of time to select a recipient and plan a program, in order for you as a member of the club to have an opportunity to submit a person for consideration for The SHA, all information must be given to the committee on or before the first meeting in March (Monday, March 2, 2020).
